Kammer is terrific at putting a human face to both sides of the immigration debate and explaining why comprehensive US immigration reform has proved so elusive. He shows us that though most Americans want a pragmatic solution, both Democrats and Republicans have polarized the debate, rousing raw emotions to advance their partisan interests. Eschewing the noise and confusion that has characterized America's recent debate on immigration policy, *Losing Control* neither panders to political interest nor peddles easy solutions. Instead, it presents a thoughtful examination of how we arrived at this point and how we can move forward. For those seeking respite from the echo chamber, this book is a must read.
